# Health Coverage Available for Former Foster Care Youth

*If you meet the requirements below, you may be eligible for Medicaid up to age 26.*

## Medicaid Eligibility Requirements:

1. Be over 18 years old but younger than 26 years old;
2. Received Medicaid at age 18 or older while a ward in foster care;
  - If you're not sure if you received Medicaid benefits at this age, call iServe at (855) 632-7633
3. Were in foster care for at least one day, and under the responsibility of any state, or a Tribe within any state, at the age of 18 or 19.

Former Foster Care youth meeting these eligibility requirements will receive full Medicaid benefits including physical health, mental health, vision, and dental services.

### By Phone:

Call the Nebraska Medicaid Customer Service Center to complete an application over the phone with a case worker.

### By Mail:

Call the Nebraska Medicaid Customer Service Center to request that a paper application be mailed to you.

### In Person:

Stop by any local DHHS office to request a paper application, which, when completed, can be mailed, faxed or electronically submitted to DHHS.
